Prescribing Information

Presentation: Moveelat Gel contains mucopolysaccharide poly-sulphuric acid ester (heparinoid) 0.2g, adrenocortical extract 1.0g (equivalent to 20mg of corticosteroids), and salicylic acid 2.0g in a colourless gel base to 100g. Moveelat Cream is also available containing the same active constituents in a white vanishing cream base.

Indications: Non-rheumatic disorders of the locomotor apparatus: sprains, muscular strains and spasms, soft tissue injuries. Rheumatic disorders: osteo-arthritis, fibrositis.

Dosage and Administration: Moveelat Gel: 2-6 inches (5-15 cm)

to be applied gently to the affected area up to four times daily; may also be used as an ultrasound coupling medium.

Moveelat Cream: 2-6 inches (5-15 cm) to be massaged into the affected area up to four times daily; may also be applied thickly with a dressing.

Contra-indications, warnings: Moveelat Gel: Contains an alcohol and therefore should not be applied to open wounds or mucous membranes. Moveelat Cream: Nil.

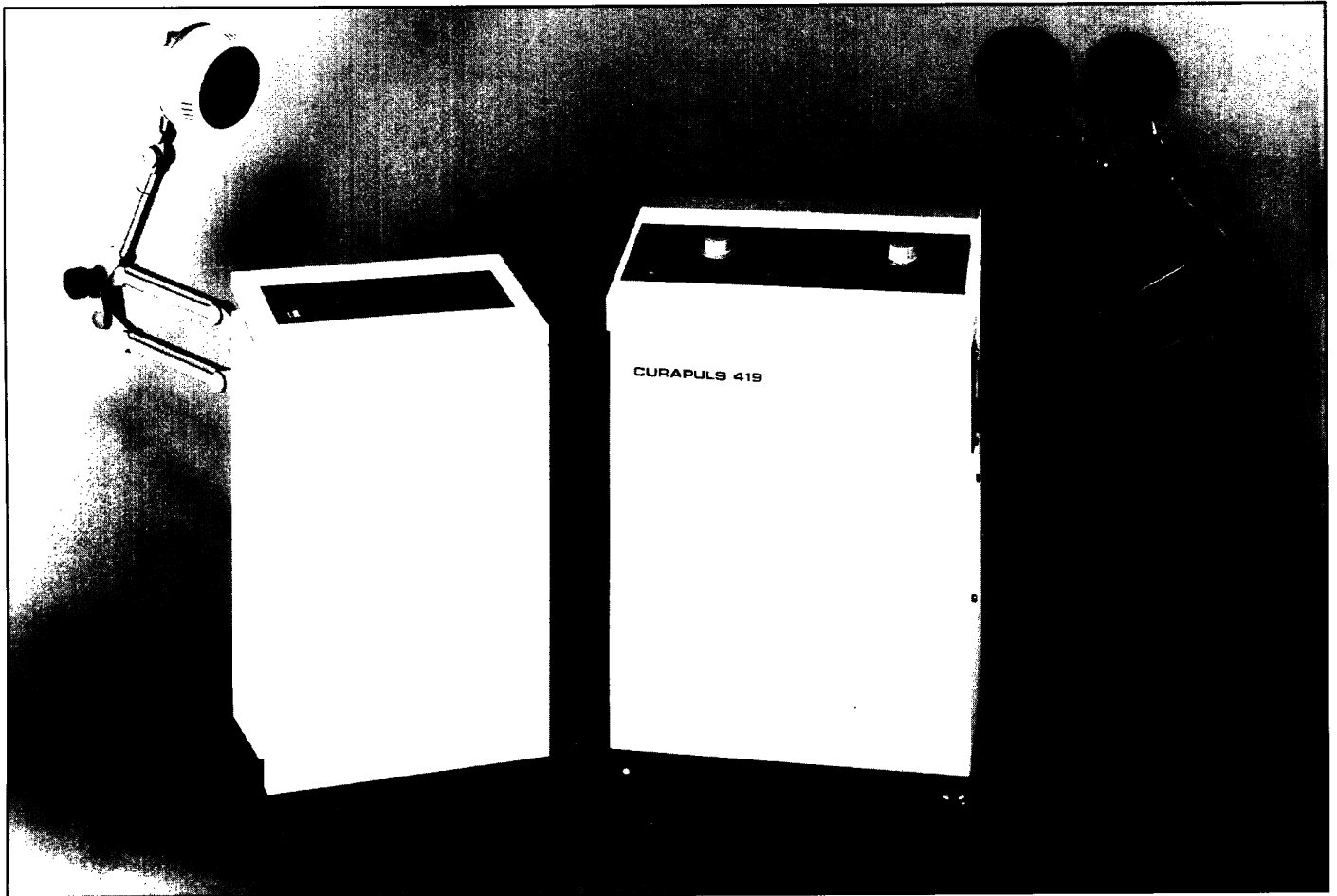
