

Appendix. Terrain park features

Jump: a snow or a snow-covered dirt pile that facilitates tricks such as grabs, twists, or spins



Half-pipe: a vertical trough similar to a cylinder where the snowboarder launches off the lip straight up into the air, rides down the lip and repeats on the opposite lip



Kicker: a ramp with a lip that projects the snowboarder into the air to facilitates aerial manoeuvres and does not have a gradual, sloping decline



Mushroom: an elevated metal dome



Rail: a metal bar that a snowboarder or skier slides along, parallel to the rail with their skis/snowboard facing across the hill



Box: various lengths and widths with a vinyl-like top, along which the snowboarder or skier slides with either their skis/snowboard facing down or across the box



Quarter-pipe: containing only one side of the half-pipe wall
